

Expedited Public Construction

The phase 1 development of Tainan Science Park is to last from July 1996 to June 2010. So far there has been general development, with the construction of public roads, transportation facilities, water/power/gas supplies, phase 1 waste water treatment plant, waste treatment plant, phase 1/2/3 standard factories, and phase 1/2 single/family dormitories have been completed to meet the construction and operational needs of park enterprises. The phase 2 development of Tainan Science Park began in July 2003 and is expected to conclude in December 2010. The exercise of eminent domain has been completed one year ahead of schedule in 2002 to provide more land for expansion and allow room for more enterprises to join the Park.

The construction project of Tainan Science Park received the Performance Awards for its outstanding implementation from the Executive Yuan on March 13, 2000 and June 26, 2002 for the fiscal years of 1999 and 2001 respectively.

Lujhu Science Park encompasses an area of 1,408 acres. The project began on July 7, 2001 and is expected to conclude in December 2010. Through partnership with Taiwan Sugar Corporation, about 723.5 million USD has been saved from the exercise of eminent domain and residential construction projects. Via its involvement in housing project management and commercial services, Taiwan Sugar Corporation can successfully transform itself for the purpose of sustainable operations.
